

Step-by-step guide to finding the museum.

Walking from: Sheffield Railway Station (Allow up to 20 minutes)

As you leave **Sheffield Railway Station**, bear right out of the main glass doors on the front of the station. (The stainless steel sculpture and waterfall should be to your left).



Using the traffic light crossing, continue to cross over **Sheaf Street** (the main carriageway) and head slightly right, following the signs for the **Sheffield Bus Interchange**.



As you arrive at the interchange's entrance, turn left up **Harmer Lane** towards Pond Street and right onto **Pond Street**.



Continue to walk along Pond Street towards **Fitzalan Square**, where you'll see the King Edward VII Statue in the centre of the square.



Using the pedestrian crossing, cross over the tram tracks heading towards **Castle Gate** (walking under the bridge) until you reach the junction of **Waingate**.



At this point, turn left, following **Castle Street**, taking a slight right onto **Snig Hill**, where you'll see Snig Hill Police Station (South Yorkshire Police).



Continue down Snig Hill on the left side of the road, taking a slight left onto **West Bar Green**, where you'll now see the main museum building at the end of this road opposite the roundabout.



Continue to the roundabout. Now, use the Zebra crossing near the museum entrance on **West Bar** (the museum entrance is to the left of the building).
